Valued Client, many of you have been asking Xeron if we can provide Covid-19 laboratory testing for the uninsured patient. Below is a description of the COVID-19 Claims Reimbursement to Health Care Providers and Facilities for Testing and Treatment of the Uninsured program.

About the Program

As part of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services will provide claims reimbursement to health care providers for **testing uninsured individuals** for COVID-19 and **treating uninsured** individuals with a COVID-19 diagnosis.

How It Works

Health care providers who have **conducted COVID-19 testing or provided treatment for uninsured** COVID-19 individuals on or after February 4, 2020, can electronically request claims reimbursement through the program and will be reimbursed generally at Medicare rates, subject to available funding.

When Referring Specimens to Xeron for COVID 19 Testing for Uninsured Patients

You must provide a properly completed requisition form for uninsured patients that has the following information: No exceptions!

- 1.) Patients full name
- 2.) Patient's Date of Birth
- 3.) Patient's **SS#/Drivers License/State ID (SS# preferred)**
- 4.) Patient's address.
- 5.) Patient's Covid-19 ICD Dx Code
- 6.) In the Insurance Company Name Box write: HRSA
- 7.) Have the Patient sign the requisition form and the Uninsured Patient Form.
